The society was registered under the Society's Registration Act in the year 1992-93. It was founded by late Prof M I Savadatti with the support of his admirers, friends, students and well wishers as a non-profit organization. Its main purpose is to address educational, environmental and social issues. The society is focusing on the capacity building of teachers, research scholars, and students. It aims at addressing local challenges through research based solutions in collaboration and networking with academic and non-academic institutions/agencies. It has organized numerous capacity building programs for science and mathematics school teachers, organised seminars and workshops to popularize science etc,. funded by DST, GOI., DoE GOK, and with its own funds.

Centre for Multi-Disciplinary Development Research

Centre for Multi-Disciplinary Development Research (CMDR) is an autonomous social science research institute recognised and financially supported by the Indian Council of Social Science Research (ICSSR), Ministry of Education, Government of India as well as Government of Karnataka.

The aims and objectives of the Centre include, conducting research on issues of socio-economic development, and decentralised planning at the sub-regional, regional and national levels in a multidisciplinary framework, covering economic, social, political and cultural dimensions of human behaviour There is also an attempt to combine judiciously the conceptual and empirical perceptions in its research studies. The Centre has aims to examine the relevance of the received theories in social sciences which have alien origins and form new theories and conceptual frames of greater relevance to Indian conditions.

The Centre has the unique advantage of providing a suitable environment for the analysis of the socioeconomic problems of the rural people and regional economy at the grass root level. Hitherto, there has been an unusual concentration of research institutions in urban and metropolitan areas in the country. Further, there is no adequate effort made to induct multi-disciplinary approach in the analysis of the socio-economic problems of the people. In North Karnataka, there is a significant scope for strengthening the institutional infrastructure for conducting socio-economic analysis of regional problems.

CMDR houses two Chairs of studies viz., Dr.D.M.Nanjundappa Chair for studies on regional imbalance and Shri Abdul Nazir Sab Panchayat Raj Chair for studies on issues associated with Panchaytiraj and

decentralization. There are Four Endowments sponsored by donors and institutions viz., Canara Bank Endowment, Teachers Day, Founders Day, and Dr. GK Kadekodi Endowment.

Unique features of CMDR include focus on the social sector, particularly Education and Health. Analysis of the socio-economic problems using micro-level data, both quantitative and qualitative, Adoption of a multidisciplinary approach to research, Integration of action research with basic research, focus on the problems of less developed states, less developed regions within the state, and less developed population groups in rural/urban areas Developing a strong database for different sectors, Promoting research interests among scholars from colleges / Universities / Research Institutes and Ph.D. program in Social Sciences.

Thrust Areas of Research include Culture, Education and Development, Agriculture, Health and Development, New Paradigms of Livelihood in the Rural Sector, Social Costs of Income-centric Development, Challenges to Sustainable Development, Tobacco and Alcohol (Economics, Control and Health Issues) Research, Scheduled Castes/ Scheduled Tribes and the Marginalised, Action Research, Capacity Building Activities and Research and Development Initiatives in Diverse Areas.

University of Agricultural Sciences, Dharwad

University of Agricultural Sciences, Dharwad, established on 1st October 1986, has the mandate to impart quality education, conduct innovative basic and applied research and undertake effective transfer of technology. The University, through its trifold functions of teaching, research and extension has been on a continuous mission to achieve its goals. University has achieved near-excellence in education through modern teaching-learning methodologies as evidenced by the global recognition of its successful graduates who have been serving in different sectors in India and abroad due to the presence of highly competent and experienced faculty. Innumerable farm technologies have been developed and released by the University for the benefit of farming community in the region in terms of enhanced production, productivity and income. Some of the innovative extension activities include Raitha Chetan Helpline (1800-425-1150) to counsel farmers in distress, Agriculture Technology Information Centre, Kiosk, Community Radio, e-pest surveillance, etc. Krishimela, an annual mega farm fair attracts more than a million people. Several successful national and international collaborative academic programmes have been executed by the University thus attracting global attention.

A leader in the field of Agricultural Education, the UAS, Dharwad is among India's most respected names in Agricultural Education and Research. An ICAR accredited University, UAS, Dharwad offers quality Under Graduate, Post Graduate and Diploma programs with constantly updated syllabi to meet the ever expanding needs of various stake holders. The University has jurisdiction over 7 districts of North Karnataka accounting for 28% of geographical area, 27% of total cultivated area and 14% of the irrigated area in the state. Great diversity in crops, soil types, climate, topography and farming conditions provide diverse entrepreneurial opportunities.

The University was bestowed with Sardar Patel Outstanding Institution Award of ICAR twice during 2000 & 2015, and first place thrice for getting the highest number of Junior Research Fellowships including 24th Dewang Mehta National Education Award (2016), Golden Globe Tigers Award (2017) for Best Educational Institute, Vasanthrao Naik Award for Research Applications in Dryland Farming Systems (2017) of ICAR, New Delhi, PPVFRA Award (2015) for registering highest number of crop hybrids and varieties with PPVFRA, New Delhi, among others. In addition, UAS, Dharwad has secured 17th Rank in India for 2017 as assessed by ICAR, New Delhi, 5th Rank among the Agricultural Universities, 58th among all Universities and 85th among all the R&D institutions in India for 2018 as awarded by the National Institutional Ranking Framework (NIRF), Ministry of HRD, Government of India. The University secured First Place during 2014-15 and Second Place during 2015-16 for securing highest number of ICAR - Junior Research Fellowships.

UAS, Dharwad has secured 9th Rank among all Agricultural Universities in the country announced by the Agricultural Education Division of the Indian Council of Agricultural Research, New Delhi, for the year 2019. Among the six farm Universities in the State, UAS, Dharwad secured 1st position consecutively for the second year.
