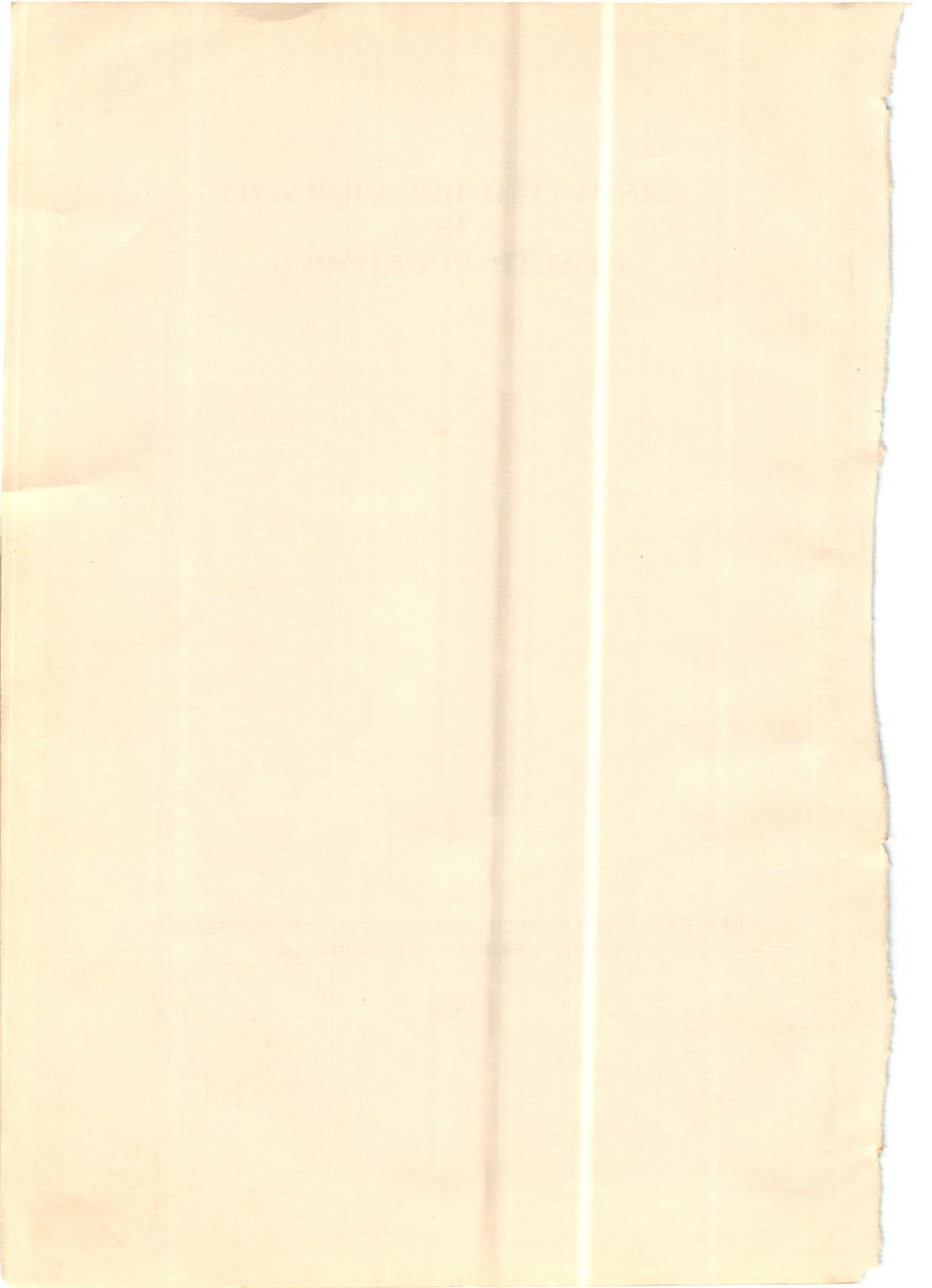

## PREFACE

Health Economics is a relatively recent addition to the science of economics. Interest in health economics was inspired significantly in the course of human capital revolution of 1960s. Though the literature in health economics progressed at a relatively slower pace than economics of education, the available studies are quite large in number to indicate the growing interest of researchers in this field. While preparing a review of the recent studies in health economics we developed an Annotated Bibliography in this field. We are happy to present the first in this series of Annotated Bibliography in health economics.

This first volume presents the annotations of 171 studies completed in India and abroad. These studies have been grouped under 14 major categories mentioned in the table of contents.

This is the first attempt that the Centre for Multi Disciplinary Development Research has undertaken. There are bound to be many errors of commission and omission in this first attempt. We request the readers to bring these to our notice for improving the other numbers in the series.
