State-level workshop on Research Methodology

The workshop was organised by KLE's Shri. Mrityunjay College of Arts and Commerce in association with CMDR, Dharwad, on 15th May 2025. The workshop on Research Methodology was designed to equip undergraduate and postgraduate students, research scholars, and faculty members with fundamental and advanced research skills. The workshop focused on techniques of collecting primary & secondary (qualitative and quantitative) data, including survey methods, interview techniques, observations, and case studies. Participants learnt how to analyze data using statistical tools and software, interpret results, and draw meaningful conclusions. The workshop also emphasized ethical considerations in research and enhanced critical thinking, problem-solving, and methodological rigor. The techniques adopted for the workshop included interactive sessions, hands-on activities, and expert guidance. Participants gained practical experience that strengthens their academic research capabilities and prepares them for future scholarly endeavors.

The workshop was organised with the following objectives

1. To equip students with knowledge of various social science data collection methods, Such as primary & Secondary data and their appropriate applications.
2. To build practical skills in analyzing both qualitative and quantitative data for meaningful interpretation and insight generation.
3. To introduce the use of statistical tools and software for efficient data processing and presentation.
4. To promote ethical awareness in research by emphasizing informed consent, confidentiality, and responsible data handling.
5. To enhance critical thinking and academic research capabilities for conducting independent and methodologically sound studies.

Participants of the workshop were faculty from 19 colleges, who represented 6 (six) districts. The students came from 16 colleges/institutions, of which the number of final year UG students was 95, the number of PG students was 24, and there were three research scholars. The number of faculty from the host college was 23, a total of 164 delegates were active participants in the workshop.

Dr. Basavaprabhu Jirli, Director, CMDR, Dharwad, delivered the inaugural address covering the overview of social science research with special reference to the Indian context. Described the differences between the research in social sciences and other areas of science and technology. Also dealt with differences between qualitative and quantitative research. The

relationship between teaching and research was also analysed with the help of appropriate anecdotes.

Dr.. Shaukat Azim, Sr. Prof of Karnataka University, Dharwad, analysed various definitions of research and steps in conducting a systematic study. Implications of artificial intelligence on social science research were also discussed for the benefit of participants.

Dr. Gururaj Hadagali from Karnataka University, Dharwad, discussed the contents of the research design in detail. The elements of data collection and analysis in social science research were taught by Dr. S. V. Hanagodimath of CMDR, Dharwad. Dr. N. C. Patil, Principal of the college, delivered the presidential address. The chairman of IQAC, faculty members of the college were present on the occasion.

Centre for Multi-disciplinary Development Research (CMDR) Director Basavaprabhu Jirli stated that research is the systematic investigation and study of materials and sources in order to establish facts and reach new conclusions.

"A research paper is a scholarly piece of writing that involves in-depth research, interpretation and analysis," he added.

He noted this while speaking after inaugurating a work-

shop on Research Methodology, organised at KLE Society's Mrityunjaya College of Arts and Commerce in Dharwad.

Further, he elaborated qualitative and quantitative methods. He highlighted about basic research and applied research. Observation is important in research, he added.

'A social weapon'

Prof Shaikat Azim in his keynote address stated that research is not mere collecting information; it is an evaluation of facts. Research is experimental and experiential. Further, he stated that research should become a social weapon. He called upon the students to undertake case studies.

Statistical tool

Dr Gururaj Hadagali focused

on contents of the Research Design. It refers to the overall strategy utilised to integrate the different components of the study in a coherent and logical way. Further, he elaborated the types of research design, such as descriptive, co-relational, experimental and diagnostic. He has explained the different statistical tools for data interpretation.

Dr Neelakka Patil presiding over the workshop said that this kind of workshop will help students to carry out quality research work and also project work, which is mandatory for final semester students. Input given by invited resource persons will instill the students to undertake research work in social science and also to enrich their knowledge.
