	(ii) A Master's Degree with at least 55% marks (or an equivalent grade in a point-scale, wherever the grading system is followed).
	(iii) A minimum of eight years of experience of teaching and/or research in an academic/research position equivalent to that of Assistant Professor in a University, College or Accredited Research Institution with a minimum of seven publications in the peer-reviewed or UGC-CARE listed journals and a total research score of Seventy five(75) as per the criteria given in Appendix II, Table2 (of UGC Regulations 2018).

General Instructions for Candidates:

1. CMDR follows UGC Regulations – 2018 regarding “Minimum Qualifications for Appointment of Teachers and Other Academic Staff in Universities and Colleges and Other Measures for the Maintenance of Standards in Higher Education”, and its subsequent amendments from time to time.
2. In order to promote merit and quality, the CMDR may consider additional quality parameters over the minimum qualifications prescribed by the UGC regulation 2018, if the number of candidates are larger than the number of candidates to be called for the interview.

3. For the post of Associate Professor, short listing will be done only on the basis of Quality Scores obtained by the candidates, who have scored the minimum qualifying score 75 for the post of Associate Professor [given in Appendix II, Table 2 of University Grants Commission (Minimum Qualifications for Appointment of Teachers and other Academic Staff in Universities and Colleges and other Measures for the Maintenance of Standards in Higher Education) Regulations, 2018].
4. The quality parameters for the post of Associate Professor as per University Grants Commission, (Minimum Qualifications for Appointment of Teachers and other Academic Staff in Universities and Colleges and other Measures for the Maintenance of Standards in Higher Education) Regulations, 2018] for Universities.
5. Notwithstanding academic scores for the short listing for interview, the final selection for all the faculty positions shall be based solely on the performance in the interview as prescribed in the UGC Regulation, 2018.
6. Any corrigendum/changes/updates related to the recruitment process shall be available on the official CMDR website (www.cmdr.ac.in).
7. Applications can be submitted any time until the cut-off date.
8. The prospective candidates must ensure that they possess requisite minimum qualification prescribed for each of the advertised position laid down in the above mentioned UGC&CMDR rules and regulations by the cut-off date for submission of the application.
9. Separate applications to be submitted if applying for more than one post.
10. Please ensure to enclose a copy of all research publications and other academic / research contributions with the application. If URL or DOI is available, then the same should be mentioned.
11. All the mandatory information must be filled, failing which the application will be considered incomplete and liable to be rejected.
12. If the candidate is in service, a hard copy of the application along with a forwarding letter to be sent within a week after the cut-off date of submission of the application.
13. The address for sending or submitting the hard copies "Office of the Registrar, CMDR, Dr. B. R. Ambedkar Nagar, Dharwad - 580004". The Post Name should be superscripted on the envelope. Only one application should be sent in one envelope.
14. If upon the verification, a candidate is found to have submitted fake documents or concealed any information at the time of appointment or any time during the tenure of the service, his/her services shall be terminated.
15. The CMDR reserves the right to withdraw any advertised post(s) at any time without citing any reason. Any consequential vacancies thus arising at the time of interview may be filled up from the available candidates. The CMDR shall also have discretion to fill up imminent vacancies in accordance with the roster points out of the available candidates. The number of vacant position(s) is thus open to change.
16. In case of any inadvertent mistake in the process of selection which may be detected at any stage even after the issue of the appointment letter, the CMDR reserves the right to modify/withdraw/cancel the appointment without any notice to the candidate.
17. In case of any dispute/ambiguity that may occur in the process of selection, the decision of the Governing Council, CMDR, Dharwad shall be final.
18. No interim correspondence shall be entertained and canvassing in any form will be a disqualification.
